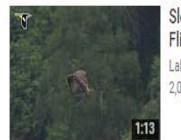

Local government units together with the provincial government of Apayao and the DENR take efforts to legislate and implement laws ( ordinances) for the protection of the Philippine Eagle



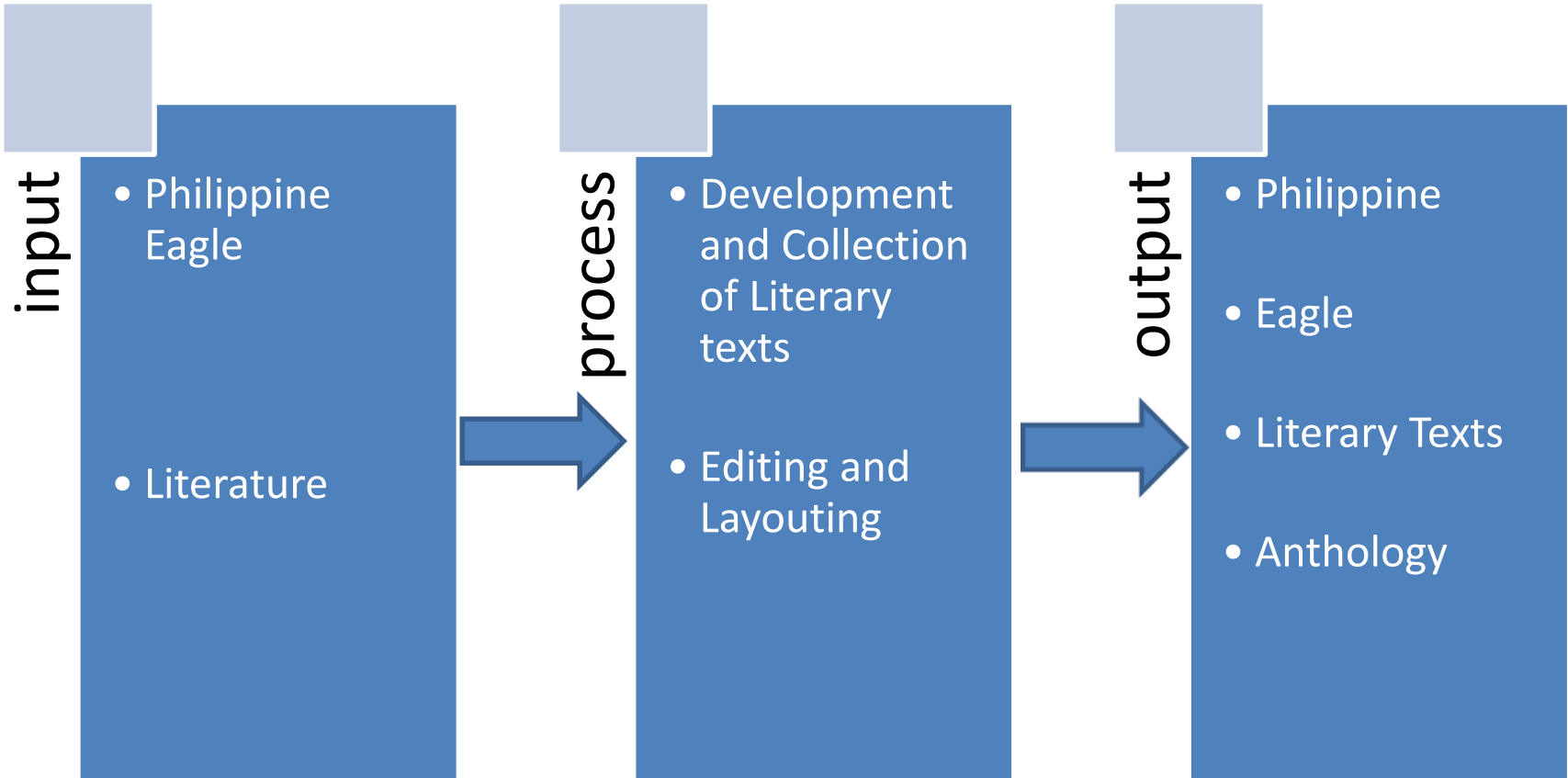
